Recycling old cell phones campaign

Our secondary school by Prince A. J. Czartoryski is taking part in collecting old cell phones. Part of the money obtained from recycling the phones is ment for grants for students of the school. The rest of the money is for charity. The event started in December 2010 when the student goverment recived an offer of co-operation from St

Claus Foundation. The aim of the campaign is not only supporting the ablest students financially but also has an ecological aspect. An old mobile phone may be dangerous for the environment, treated as hazardous waste and should be selectively collected. Then it should undergo a recycling and neutralizing poisonous substances process. On the Foundation site we read that phones ment for recycling are sorted out into 3 categories: to be repaired and sold ones, those from which some parts can be retrieved and finally those to be destroyed in order to recycle the material. Joining the campaign the school promotes smart and talented students and environment – friendly attitude and behaviour.

Our students systematically encourage other pupils to take part in the event by making announcements or hanging on posters with relevant information. Helping friends is especially satisfactory and motivates to action.

In order to support the campaign one needs to deliver to our school building a cell phone without a SIM card. Old charges are also collected.
